

GOD/OMNIPRESENCE

David said, “Whither shall I go from thy spirit? or whither shall I flee from thy presence? If I ascend up into heaven, thou art there: if I make my bed in hell, behold, thou art there. If I take the wings of the morning, and dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea; Even there shall thy hand lead me, and thy right hand shall hold me: (Psalm 139:7-10).

When we think of God’s omnipresence, we usually think in terms as God being present in all places. The truth of omnipresence is that there is no place where God is not. So often the first part of the word is overlooked. The ‘omni’ relates not only to the places where God is, but also to how much of Him is in any given place.

It has been noted that, God is not only present in all places, but fully present in all places. This is what we call God’s immensity. His immensity does not refer to His size, but to His ability to be fully present everywhere. God is in all places at all times. This may be difficult doctrine for some to understand, but nevertheless, it is a solid Bible doctrine concerning God.

Jesus said that God is spirit; therefore God cannot be limited to space as objects are. God is everywhere present; there is no place to hide from Him.
