

WHAT IS THE FATAL FLAW OF EVOLUTION?

(Genesis 1:11-12, 20, 24; 2:7)

My interest in evolution began in the autumn of 2003 at which time I came across some material that was very interesting. I had never read, but had often thought about our make-up as human beings and how that this make-up must speak of a source outside of the elements that evolutionists so highly speak of. At that time, I did not believe the theory of evolution, nor do I believe it today. Evolution and evolutionists as many see it today have not studied as thoroughly this subject as they should have. It is only a tool of Satan to deceive man.

I recently saw a program in which the evolution of man was described. The program was on the History Channel. In this program many things were given to support the Ape-Man theory. However, they overlooked (purposely) the truth about the Java man, Peking man, and the Piltdown man.

Dr. Henry Morris, president of the Institute for Creation Research in San Diego California, said: “The bones of the original Java man (*Pithecanthropus erectus*) have been recognized as belonging to two different creatures – the skull to a gibbon [a small, slender, long-armed ape of India], the femur [the thighbone] to a man. The fossils of the Peking man were quite controversial from the beginning, but in any case, were lost during World War II. Piltdown man, of course, is now universally acknowledged to be a hoax – but a hoax that fooled the world’s leading anthropologists for decades.”

But the fatal flaw to evolution is the make-up of DNA. DNA is the code of life. Dr. Norman Geisler when commenting on DNA said: “The Grand Canyon and Niagara Falls require only the blind forces of wind and water to shape them. The same cannot be said for Mount Rushmore or a hydroelectric plant. These required intelligent intervention.”
